



WAUKESHA SOUTH BANDS CONCERT WEAR

An ensemble's appearance to the audience helps to set the tone of a performance even before the first note is played. The Waukesha South Bands are very proud of the visual, as well as the musical, impression it makes upon its audience. Our uniforms provide a classy, consistent look throughout our organization that enhances and never distracts from our performances.

Men – Thanks to fund-raising efforts of the band boosters, we are now able to provide the men with a full tuxedo. The outfit includes a black tuxedo jacket, black tuxedo pants, a white tuxedo shirt, and a bow tie and cummerbund. Each man will need to provide themselves with black dress shoes and black dress socks. Generally speaking, if the tuxedo shirt is dry-cleaned after every performance, the tuxedo itself does not need dry cleaning as often. If a hem is needed, it should be sewn by hand, not machine. Bow ties and cummerbunds do not require cleaning.

Women – The school will provide all women with a formal dress uniform. Each woman will need to provide themselves with neutral colored hosiery and black dress shoes. Following every performance, the dress should be machine washed and dried. If a hem is needed, it should be sewn by hand, not machine.

Uniforms have been provided by band and band booster fundraising. Events like the chili feed and Marchfest have been instrumental in providing us with the uniforms. These uniforms will provide us with many years of wear. Please keep them clean and properly stored on a hanger. Uniforms will be assigned yearly and students should store them at home during the school year.

At the conclusion of each concert season it is each student's responsibility to return the uniform to the band directors. The end of the year dry-cleaning is included with your band fees. Uniforms not returned by the turn in date will have a financial obligation form turned into the office.

Uniforms are to be worn only for Waukesha South Music Department performances. They are not to be worn for private events or other school events. For example, tuxes should not be worn to your cousin's wedding or to prom.
